NSEFI Chairman Pranav R Mehta and HAI President Dr R K Malhotra signed this MoU in the presence of Dr. V K Saraswat, Dr. Anil Kakodkar and Shri Tarun Kapoor. The MoU was signed during the National Roundtable on Challenges and Opportunities for Green Hydrogen in India jointly organized by NSEFI and HAI.

Through this initiative NSEFI in partnership with HAI will drive the industry response to promote indigenous manufacturing, advocating policy measures and supporting Pilot projects while facilitating Industry Academia Collaboration.

The roundtable witnessed two panel discussions with stellar panelists encompassing entire Green Hydrogen Value Chain.





The first session chaired by Dr. V K Saraswat, Member Niti Ayog and Co-Chaired by Dr. Anil Kakodkar deliberated on future of Green Hydrogen in India and the measures required to make it viable. The Second session saw panelists discuss about Industry Academia collaboration.
